



Online dos and don'ts

The internet is a valuable **source** of information. However, there is a lot of information on the internet that is false or **out of date**. Many students use information from the first website in a search list and don't think about quality. This is not a good idea. It is important to check the websites you use are **reliable**. Use this checklist to help.

● Is the information on the website old or new?

When you want to know something about science or news, you must check the date on the website. Is the date recent? It is important that the information is **up to date**.

● Who wrote the information?

Can you find the name of the author? If it is a famous person or organisation, then it is probably a reliable site. Look at the website address. If the site is from a government or an institution, then it is reliable.

● What is the website for?

If the site is selling a product, the information is not always accurate.
