Natural disasters

(A)

Earthquakes happen when two large pieces of the Earth's crust, called tectonic plates, suddenly move. The movement causes shock waves that shake the surface of the Earth in the form of an earthquake. The seismic waves are most powerful at the centre of the earthquake and they move at 20 times the speed of sound.

(B)

A flood is a natural event that occurs when a piece of land that is usually dry suddenly goes under water. When floods happen in an area where people live, the water carries along houses, bridges, cars, furniture, trees, animals and even people.

(C)

A hurricane is a strong tropical rain with powerful winds. It can create tornadoes, high waves and lots of flooding. Hurricanes form over warm ocean waters near the equator. They rotate around a circular centre called the 'eye'. Inside the eye there aren't any winds or clouds but around it there is the 'eye wall', the most dangerous part of the hurricane.

(D)

An earthquake or volcanic eruption in the sea creates waves called a tsunami. These waves move quickly and for very long distances – a tsunami can travel thousands of kilometres across the ocean at 800 km an hour. As the waves get closer to land they become taller, like huge walls of water. Tsunamis are very dangerous and can completely destroy coastal towns.
