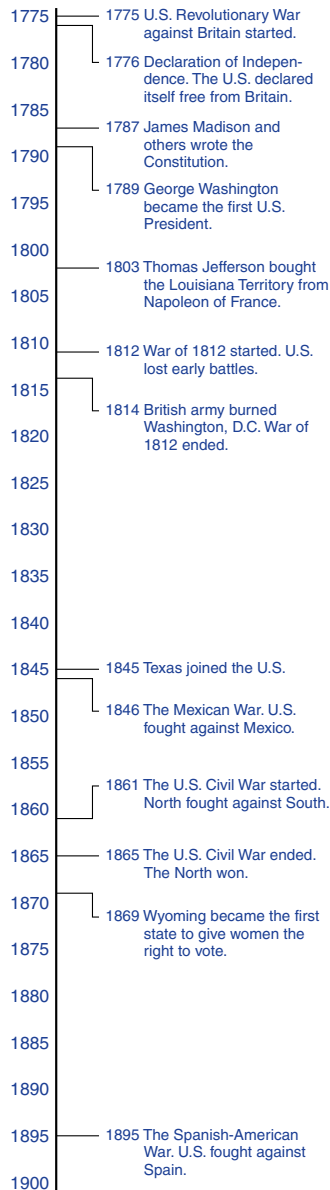


When Did It Happen?
