Funny Sentences

A group activity making sentences with passive forms.

- Cut out the cards, keeping the cards in each column together (1, 2, 3, 4).
- Put the class into groups of four.
- Give each group a set of the cards. They should be kept in separate piles 1, 2, 3, 4.
- The students put the cards out on the table, but should keep the piles together.
- Pick one student from each group to start.
- The first student must choose a card from pile 1. He must say the word with an article if necessary.

e.g. A leprechaun ...

• Then the second person must choose a verb card from the second pile. She must repeat what the first person said then continue, using a passive form.

e.g. A leprechaun was taken ...

• Now the third person repeats and takes a card from the third pile to continue (and will probably need to add a preposition and article).

e.g. A leprechaun was taken to a pub ...

• The fourth person must finish the sentence with a card (and additional words) from Pile 4.

e.g. A leprechaun was taken to a pub on a lovely island in the Irish sea.

- The groups see how many sentences they can make in five minutes.
- At the end, ask some of the groups to tell the class some interesting or funny sentences.
