



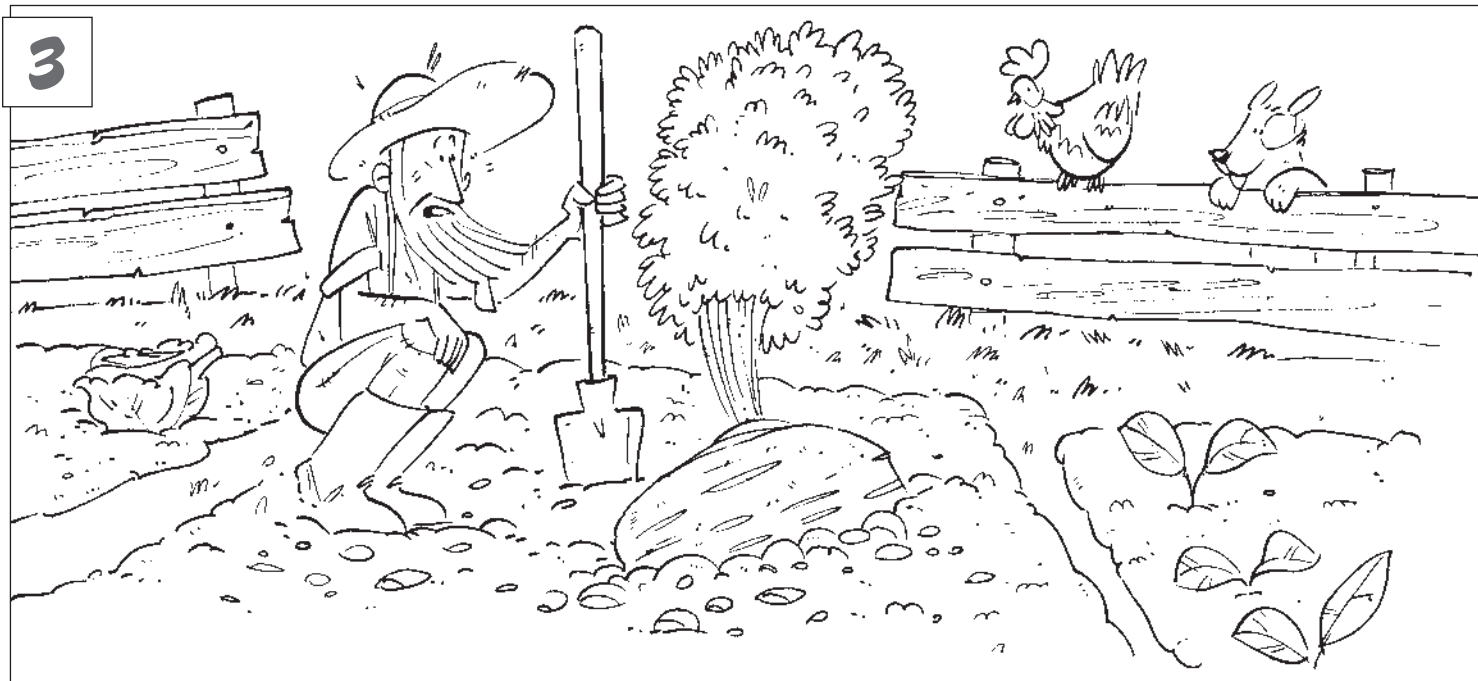
Narrator: This is a story about a farmer and a very, very big carrot.

the carrot up²!

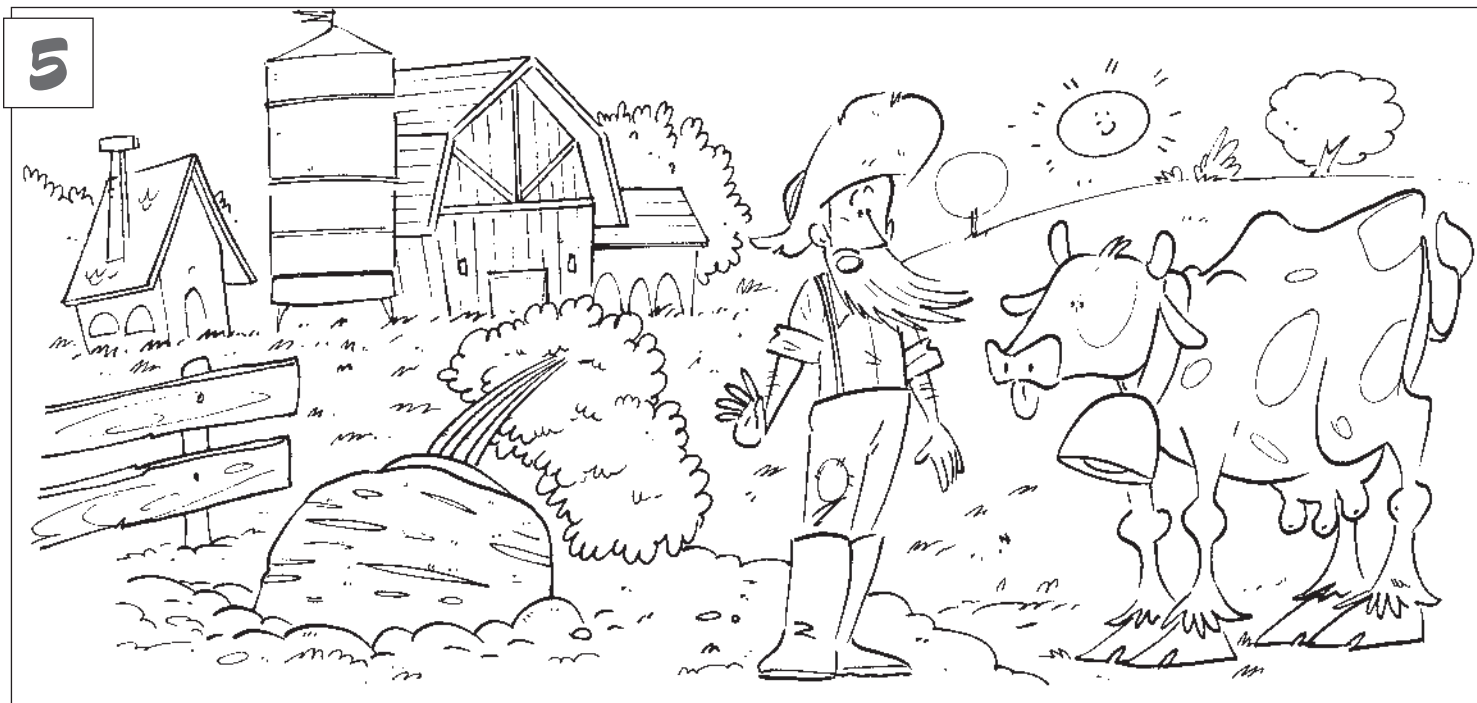
