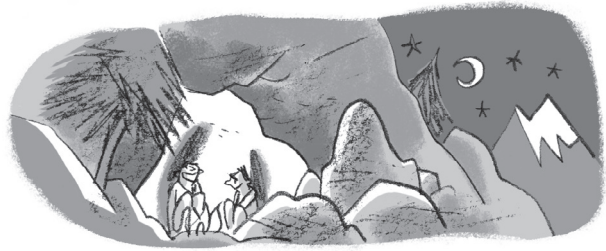


THE FIRST USES OF FIRE

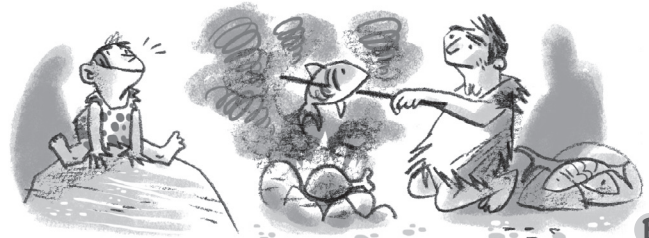
