

An Easter Chick Action Rhyme

Chicks have become associated with Easter because they come from the egg – another symbol of new life. Here is a simple action rhyme that also teaches vocabulary about chicks.

Inside the egg

peck, peck with a beak.

Out pops a head to take a little peek.

Out step two legs,

out flap two wings.

Here's little fluffy chick that Easter always brings!

- (arch arms over head, hands joined to represent the egg)
- (make one hand into a beak shape and pretend to tap the side of the egg)
- (put hands horizontally, fingertips joined in front of your face and look over the top)
- (pretend to step out of the egg)
- (flap both arms as if trying to fly)
- (crouch down on the ground like a baby chicken)
