

An Easter Chick Action Rhyme

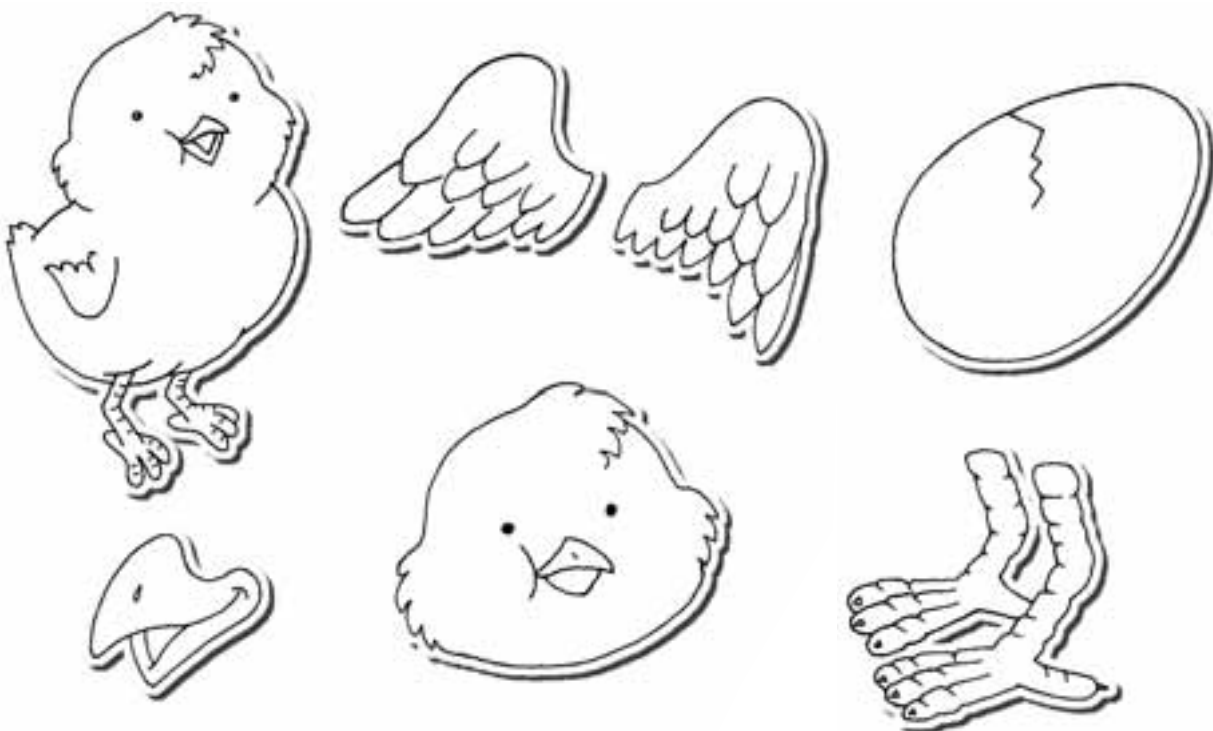

Chicks have become associated with Easter because they come from the egg – another symbol of new life. Here is a simple action rhyme that also teaches vocabulary about chicks.

|---|---|---|
| Inside the egg | → | (arch arms over head, hands joined to represent the egg) |
| peck, peck with a beak. | → | (make one hand into a beak shape and pretend to tap the side of the egg) |
| Out pops a head to take a little peek. | → | (put hands horizontally, fingertips joined in front of your face and look over the top) |
| Out step two legs, | → | (pretend to step out of the egg) |
| out flap two wings. | → | (flap both arms as if trying to fly) |
| Here's little fluffy chick that Easter always brings! | → | (crouch down on the ground like a baby chicken) |
